Primary Purpose

The Contemporary Worship Leader

Qualifications

- 1. Understand worship leadership as a ministry and possess a willingness to engage in pastoral activities as necessary
- 2. Demonstrated ability to read music, sing and/or play an instrument (keyboard or guitar preferred).
- 3. Demonstrated ability to develop, empower, and shepherd a volunteer worship team.
- Technical proficiency—Ability to interact effectively with technical team. Must have a working knowledge of sound boards and sound equipment.
- 5. Experience in a leadership position.
- 6. Must have a two-year associate degree or equivalent work experience.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Collaboratively plan worship services in conjunction with ministry staff based on sermon topic/ theme and other directional goals.
- 2. Serve as the primary worship leader vocally and instrumentally.
- 3. Contribute creative ideas for weekly services, such as soloists, theatrics, youth, and special presentations.
- 4. Assist in planning flow of worship for Sunday morning and special services (Christmas Eve, Easter Morning, and other special church events).
- 5. Recruit, develop and manage volunteer musicians and vocalists. Recruit, develop and manage technical team to ensure competency in audio and video support for the worship team.
- 6. Select music, scripture, prayers and other elements of worship that will engage an intergenerational congregation.
- 7. Coordinate and conduct rehearsals at a minimum of once per week and directly prior to performances.
- 8. Develop, enhance, and maintain an aesthetically pleasing environment that is appropriate for contemporary worship.
- 9. Coordinate support staff for the worship service such as set-up, refreshments, and attendance book distribution and collection.
- 10. Regularly coordinate with the Pastor to ensure appropriate communication and planning in preparation for the worship service.
- 11. Support the development and recruitment of members for a Worship Design Team. Provide leadership and support for this team to ensure integration of ideas that will enhance the worship experience.
- 12. Be responsible for the use and storage of music, equipment and other related materials utilized in the program.
- 13. Perform other related duties as assigned by the pastor/SPRC.
